<p align="center">SCHOOL DISTRICT</p> <p align="center">GALLATIN GATEWAY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 35 TRUSTEE ELECTION THREE YEAR TERM VOTE FOR TWO</p> <p><input type="radio"/> JULIE FLEURY</p> <p><input type="radio"/> LESSA RACOW</p> <p><input type="radio"/> _____</p> <p><input type="radio"/> _____</p>		<p>Shall the Gallatin Gateway School District be authorized to impose a building reserve in the amount of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) per year for five (5) years and being approximately 6.61 mills, for a total amount of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000.00), for the purpose of properly maintaining, equipping, furnishing, remodeling and retro-fitting buildings and grounds of the district?</p> <p>Passage of this proposal will result in an annual tax of \$8.92 on a home with an assessed market value of \$100,000 and \$17.85 on a home with an assessed market value of \$200,000.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> BUILDING RESERVE - YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> BUILDING RESERVE - NO</p>		<p>Shall the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of High School District No. 7 (Bozeman), Gallatin County, Montana (the "District"), be authorized to sell and issue general obligation school building bonds of the District in one or more series in the total principal amount of up to One Hundred Twenty-five Million and No/100 Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), bearing interest at rates to be determined at the time of the sale, payable semiannually, during a term as to each series of bonds of not more than twenty (20) years (or, if then permitted, thirty (30) years), for the purpose of accommodating enrollment growth by paying the costs of designing, constructing, furnishing and equipping a new high school on land the District owns bounded by Flanders Mill, Cottonwood, and Durston Roads and the future Oak Street in Bozeman and making associated improvements, including site work such as roads, parking lots, and playing fields on District-owned property and property that serves or is adjacent to the District-owned property, which may include land leased from the City of Bozeman (the "City"); demolishing, reconfiguring, equipping and furnishing portions of Bozeman High School and undertaking associated site work, including roads, parking lots, playing fields, and stadium improvements; making related improvements; and paying the costs associated with the sale and issuance of the bonds?</p> <p>A vote for the above proposition includes a vote for authorizing the Board to lease from the City for a term of up to 99 years for rent of \$1 per year City-owned land located to the north of the future Oak Street and adjacent to the new high school property owned by the District; a vote against the above proposition includes a vote against authorizing the Board to lease from the City such land under such terms.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> BONDS - YES</p> <p><input type="radio"/> BONDS - NO</p>

<p align="center">GALLATIN GATEWAY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 35 GENERAL FUND LEVY</p> <p>Shall the Gallatin Gateway School District Trustees be authorized to impose an increase in over-base local taxes to support the General Fund of Thirty-One Thousand, Two-Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$31,211), which is an increase of approximately 5.89 mills for the purpose of properly maintaining and operating the programs of the district?</p> <p>Passage of this proposal will increase the annual taxes on a home with an assessed market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$7.95 and on a home with an assessed market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$15.90. The durational limit of the levy is intended to be permanent.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> FOR the additional Levy</p> <p><input type="radio"/> AGAINST the additional Levy</p>		<p>Shall the Bozeman High School District Trustees be authorized to impose an increase in over-base local taxes to support the General Fund in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000), which is an increase of approximately 0.78 mills for the purpose of properly maintaining and operating the programs of the district?</p> <p>Passage of this proposal will increase the annual taxes on a home with an assessed market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$1.05 and on a home with an assessed market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$2.10.
