Instructional Goals

Instructional programs, methods, and materials will not imply, teach, or encourage any beliefs or practices reflecting bias or discrimination toward other individuals or groups and will not deny others their basic human rights.

The District has developed a Statement of Learner Goals that is available through the District Office. This philosophical goal statement will be publicized and made available to interested citizens. This statement will be reviewed annually and revised as deemed necessary.
